“Boot Prints” by Step by Step

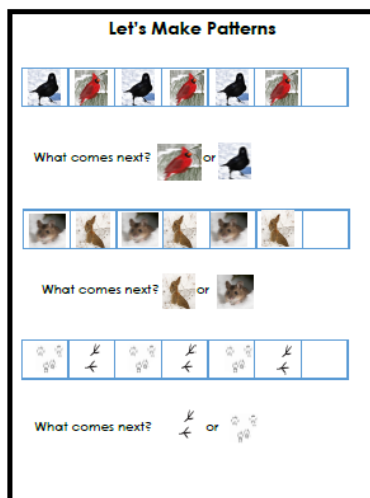
Up and down the yard we go
