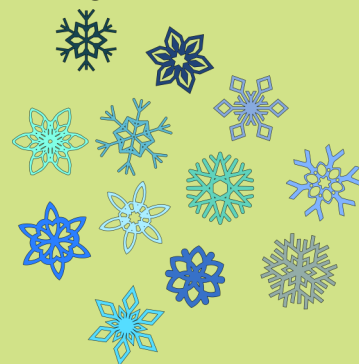
Little snowflakes falling down,

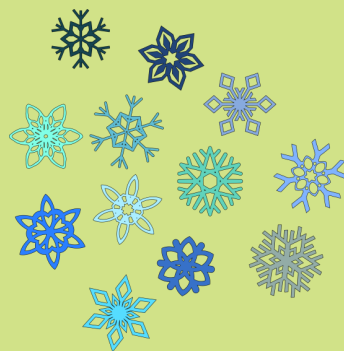
