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# **Literacy Activity Comprehension Questions**

(After listening to story)

Why did most everybody go INSIDE? To stay safe from COVID-19.

#### Who needed to be at work?

Doctors, nurses, ambulance drivers, firefighters, police, teachers, etc.

### What kinds of things were people doing **INSIDE?**

Baking, cooking, making music, reading, watching TV, playing games, working, etc.

Continue asking questions like these to strengthen child's comprehension skills.

## **Dramatic Play or Music Activity**

#### Picnic Lunch

Pack a basket full of real or pretend food to take on a picnic. Ask questions like:

- "What shall we put **inside** the basket?"
- "What is **inside** this box, bottle, the refrigerator, the cabinet?"
- "Shall we have our picnic **inside** or outside?"
