

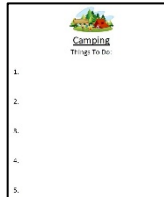

Dramatic Play or Music Activity Nature Art

Math Activity Stick Maze

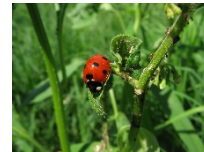
Collect sticks from around your yard, park, or campsite. Have your child count or help them count the number of sticks collected.



Help your child use the sticks to make a maze to walk through. If you have a ball, they can practice rolling the ball through the maze.

Science Activity I Spy...

Play a game of I Spy. This expands your child's vocabulary while learning to identify attributes of different items.



Here is an example of clues you might give for the ladybug:

- I spy something red.
- I spy something that walks and flies.
- I spy something that has black dots on its back.

Keep adding clues until your child guesses the correct answer. Have your child try giving clues next.
