

deer

Deer stay outside all winter and bed down together in pine needles under pine trees for warmth at night.



badger

Badgers reduce their activity during the winter but they do not hibernate.



bear

Bears are hibernators. They stay in their dens. They sleep and wake during that time.



hedgehog

Hedgehogs do hibernate from October to April. They stay in their dens but do not sleep.



rabbit

Rabbits graze all year long outside no matter the weather.



skunk

Skunks do not hibernate; they huddle together in their dens to stay warm.
